RE: Emergency Notification to Cell Phones

The Butler Office of Emergency Management and the Morris Co. Office of Emergency Management wishes to advise residents and business owners it is now possible to have your residents register their cellular phones for notification via the Morris County Emergency Notification system. This is the Morris County version of the reverse 9-1-1 emergency notification system.

By doing so, emergency notification calls made to a geographic area will include cell phones at addresses included in the call-out area. Residents/business owners can register up to three cell phones per address location.

It is important that this is not an instant update, but could take 1-3 months depending on the data update cycle. Residents/business owners are advised that because of the unforeseen nature of some large-scale emergencies, no one can fully guarantee that they will receive a notification every time.
