Basic Skill Program Description

Basic Skills will be implemented primarily as a push-in program integrated into Technology classes and Language Arts/Math classes. Students will receive pull out instruction as needed to remediate specific skills and to provide additional Orton Gillinham instruction. Instruction will include, but not be limited to, NJLS Curriculum, RAZ Kids, Research Based Intervention Materials (RTI), Preventing Academic Failure (Ortin Gillingham) and teacher created materials. For Language Arts instruction, the Reading Workshop model will be used to deliver targeted instruction as prescribed by each ISIP. Six certified, grade level specific, Elementary School Teachers will provide this instruction throughout the school day (40 periods per week). A needs assessment will be completed by the classroom teacher for all students recommended and specific criteria as established for each grade level.
