I hope this email finds you well and doing final preparations for your holidays - I absolutely love this time of year. As I shared in my last newsletter,

we have spent time meeting as a leadership team to make arrangements and plans for our return to our hybrid schedule. We have held meetings with the Department of Health to help inform our conversations. In all, we have made the determination that we will remain in a <u>full virtual setting through the first</u> <u>week of January, with a return to our hybrid instructional schedule on January</u> <u>11, 2021</u>.
