SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT:

a. Good News and Progress in Our Schools

I would like to take this time to honor the members of the Butler Board of Education. Each January, The State of New Jersey, in partnership with New Jersey School Boards, celebrates the volunteers of our State's Boards of Education. In total, New Jersey has approximately 5,000 local Board of Education members. These individuals devote countless hours, without remuneration, to the oversight of school district operations, including finances, policy, curriculum, and personnel. Many do not see these efforts particularly the amount of time spent within the committee meetings, reviewing weekly information, and discussing solutions to concerns within Executive Sessions. A lot of work and preparation goes into each month's Board of Education meetings, with the members of the Butler Board of Education dedicating up to 20 hours per month in this endeavor. No other public official, elected or appointed, has a



greater impact on the lives of children than the local school board member. Over the past few years, boards of education in New Jersey faced and overcame many unprecedented challenges. The Butler Board of Education is recognized for their efforts in many things from navigating the pandemic to facility upgrades that our community had asked for during our Strategic Planning sessions.
